



Requirements for membership application

- a. To become a full member of the EuroCTO club **you have to have an experience of CTOs of at least 300 cases, and** you need to document at least 100 CTO procedures personally performed in 2 successive years. You have to fill the data sheet ([http://www.eurocto.eu/data sheet for entry.doc](http://www.eurocto.eu/data%20sheet%20for%20entry.doc)) and send it with 2 written recommendations by club members to:

Membership will be accredited after 1 year of associated membership with participation in the clubs registry and consecutive agreement of at least two board members (that is in the statute) upon application.

- b. Membership can only be **upheld** if you consecutively enter all personal CTO cases in the online registry of the club. **Failure to do so leads to termination of the membership upon decision of the board. All those who did not respond to our repeated reminders non contributing to the registry over 2 years, should now become associate members and have one year of time to fulfill the criteria.**
- c. Membership will be **put on hold (from “full” to “associated”)** if less than 50 CTO cases per year are entered in the registry in 2 consecutive years.
- d. Members commit to actively participate in studies organized by the club (participation in 1/3 studies should be striven for).
- e. Members should gather at least once a year - preferably at one of the large interventional meetings or at a ECC-meeting.
- f. The club will be organizing **one** major CTO-meeting per year or every other year. Active participation of all club members is crucial, including all efforts to promote the meeting locally and country-wide.
- g. Club members who know of dedicated high-volume CTO-operators who are not yet a member but would fulfill the membership criteria should ask them to join the club.
